Club Policy – Affordability

- It is the policy of Painswick Golf Club to promote golf to all members of the community with no discrimination by ethnicity, religion, sex or age. HMRC have highlighted the inflationary effects on the costs of running sports club; subscriptions have increased in recent years to cause affordability to become an issue for some members and an inhibition to potential new members.
- As members of CASC (Community of Amateur Sports Clubs) we have developed a policy to prevent such discrimination by advertising for new members at discounted rates. We also wish to address the issue of subscriptions and costs exceeding £10 per week (£520 p.a) being unaffordable for some of our members who may have low or modest incomes.
- With immediate effect we invite any member currently paying a subscription of over £520 per annum (i.e. a 7 day member, as all other categories do not apply) and is unable to afford the subscription and costs due to low income, to contact the Honorary Secretary, Ann Smith. Written details of income demonstrating inability, through low or modest income, to continue their membership will be required.

The Secretary will provide details of alternatives that will enable membership to continue, which will include:

- 5 day membership, based on 4 weekdays plus either Saturday or Sunday
- Payment on a weekly basis of £10 per round
- Reduction of subscription to below £450 p.a in the event of redundancy for a period up to 3 months
- Provision already exists for those with injury or illness
